

ELUCC Meeting *JAN 5th, 2017* PO Box 582, Lebanon, Oregon 97355

The meeting was called to order by President Kevin Hamilton. Minutes from the December meeting were not present to be reviewed.

Treasurer's Report: \$2,150.97 is the year-end balance. Joyce has mailed out dues invoices to members. We expect to receive about \$5,000 in dues payments.

Damage Report: Nothing reported

Standards Report:Tobin reviewed OAR 952-001-0040, "Pre-Marking Required by the
Excavator; Exemption".
Discussion was had regarding an "excavator shall pre-mark...", and with
regard to understanding the exemptions outlined in paragraph 2.
Recommendation is to always pre-mark in white the area of excavation,
AND provide a good description when calling in the dig ticket.

State Council Report: No news to report this month.

- P & E Report:We will be purchasing six pack coolers with the 811 logo on the side to
promote dig safe awareness, along with other handouts including
notebooks, pens, letter openers, & etc. We agreed to spend \$150 for the
purchase of additional safety glasses as promotional items.
Larry provides support, as requested, to the cities of Sweet Home,
Lebanon, and Scio, and to LBCC for their public safety outreach efforts.
We discussed ELUCC's presence at the Linn County Fair, and discussed
the possibility of a combined effort with LBUCC
- Old Business:Lynn reviewed the results of the survey (Survey Monkey) she sent out on
December 8th (attached).
We discussed the proposed new days for the ELUCC meeting. We
observed that the State Council meeting is on the second week of the
month. This creates a conflict for ELUCC officers who also serve on the
State Council. Lynn will compose a new survey to gage support for
different days in the first week of the month for the ELUCC monthly
meeting.
