September's minutes were read and approved.

<u>Treasures Report</u>: We have a balance of \$786.44.. This includes the initial \$1,000 from the state. We made another request for an additional #\$1,000 from the state. This 2^{nd} one was denied initially, but the 2^{nd} time (on the 2^{nd} request) was approved. It was ear-marked for P&E tshirts and the 2014 tidebooks.

<u>P&E</u>: Ken will talk to the local radio stations about placement of a free ad getting out our message for free of "Dig Safely and/or 811". Our council should still qualify for this free service.

<u>Damages</u>: Alan Lee told us none were reported. Ken will assume the damages position within Coastcom. NW Natural, Pioneer, and Pacific power are our typical three reporters which satisfies the state requirement.

Standards Report: Gary is optimistic the new manual will come out around the first part of 2014.

<u>Old Business</u>: The new venue of the "Side Door Café" was discussed. Most reviews were favorable. We need to get photos of the officers to satisfy the state's requirement.

<u>States Report</u>: As mentioned in the attached "President's Letter", a Train-the-Trainer program will be at the next quarterly meeting. Also is a description of the requests for council's extra \$1,000 funding. The next quarterly meeting will be December 11th in Salem at the Oregon Gardens.

<u>New Business</u>: The 20" x 30" metal signs were discussed. It was decided we would ask for 5; they are free. A motion was made and passed to purchase 6000, 2014 tidebooks from 2014. November will involve officer nominations for 2014, December will be the officers' election time.
