OLD BUSINESS:

RAA - Next hearing date is unknown at this time. Hearings are at the PUC Building at 550 Capitol St NE, Salem. Be sure to bring change for the parking meters if you attend. Everyone is invited to attend, but you can only watch & not participate.

Adam Franco & Anita Floyd reported that the OAR committee is working changing the language to make the verbiage more understandable, i.e. "excavating". Changes are to be made this summer/fall.

James Lawrence is going to get with Lane County UCC for a list of guest speakers that they have had in the past, as they have had quite a few.

Adam asked that we notify him if we hear of anyone having issues using "811", as it has been expressed that using a cell phone from other areas directs people to the incorrect state.

We discussed that we would like to have guest speakers on at least a quarterly basis. We will discuss further at our next meetings to set something up. Adam asked that we give him any recommendations.

Adam Franco is still waiting on Tina Beech w/ Cascade Natural to look into partnering with us & others to fund a contractor's dinner with guest speakers. Adam will get more details. Tina has contacted Adam with some information. Adam will get that information to us.

Anita Floyd shared some information about a new dig law that is being looked into being passed. This law would consist of excavators not having to call for locates if excavating is less than 12" or is using hand tools. Anita asked for any assistance with examples of any known damages caused by either method.

It had been previously discussed that we could file RAA's as a council for those active members who felt awkward filing directly. Adam Franco will look into getting a "form" letter that is being currently used by Douglas UCC.

The holiday calendar observed by the One-Call was discussed as there was a change on the Friday after Thanksgiving. It was not observed this year as a legal holiday as it had been in the past & caught Locating Companies by surprise. Adam Franco will discuss with the OUNC board if it is possible to add a link on their website of the legal holidays that will be observed by them in the future. The website they use is http://www.opm.gov.

A motion was passed in October to by-pass the By Laws for 2013 until they can be reviewed & reworded if needed.

The OUNC has asked Michael Thompson to put together a summary of the RAA hearings. This would benefit the local councils to help promote education to the local contractors in the areas where infractions are the highest.

811 Locate Requesting is available 24/7! Don't wait until first thing Monday morning to call in your locates – you'll find the lines are packed with everyone else calling at the same time! Call Saturday or Sunday if you want to get your request in early. Still expect two (2) business days for the locates to show up!

Should you encounter an un-located utility while excavating – stop digging, call 811 to report it immediately, determine that there is no immediate danger, and you can continue working (if your project allows) using extreme care in the affected area. See Page 23 (5) in the Standards Manual.

NEW BUSINESS:

Adam Franco reported the stats from the Managers Report as follows: Incoming 2013 = 25,475 –this is up 12.96% from 2012
Outgoing 2013 = 150,561 –this is up 18.17% from 2012
