Damage Report:

Be sure to report your damages each month!

All damage reports need to be made using the Damage Information Reporting Tool (DIRT) from the Common Ground Alliance (CGA). You can check this out at www.cga-dirt.com. There is a link to (DIRT) on the OUCC website. Pease sign up and start reporting. Additional information on how to use DIRT and share your general reporting info will be coming soon from the OUCC. Oregon is still talking about making reporting mandatory.

PUC and OSHA are very active now. This may help with the RAA process.

NOTE: Only facility owners should submit reports on their facilities. This will prevent double reporting should excavators report on a damage they did to a facility owner. It only takes minutes each month!!
