Cascade Natural Gas:

- Wind farm is closing out their project west of Ontario.
- City of Vale notified Kyle that a fiber optic line was hit during a project, locates were called in however this line was not located. Vale called 811 to notify them a line was hit, but no one has responded. Kyle said proper protocol was followed.
- Oregon Utility Notification Council meeting will be Dec. 14-15 at Seven Feathers in Canyonville, south of Grants Pass. Attendees will be discussing changes to funding and they are also going to nominate a new president following a recent resignation.
- Kyle will also bring up the problem of locates box encompassing too large an area creating a
 waste of time and resources for utilities nowhere near some project areas. Kyle will bring it up to
 the OUNC and report back in January.
- CNG will also bring 811 Dig Line T-shirts to the next meeting.

Ontario/CH2M:

- Waremart/Winco paved their half of Goodfellow Street. Sewer and water has been extended to the west property owned by Sathers. Waremart is tentatively scheduled to open in February 2017.
- Just a reminder that City of Ontario requires a right of way permit for working in the City right of
 way. If there is ever any question whether a right of way permit is needed, please call to verify. Or
 if any the utilities need a copy of their franchise agreement with the City of Ontario, or a copy of
 the City's Right of Way Ordinance or permit fee schedule, please contact Dan Shepard at 541889-8572 at the CH2M Public Works Shop. Regardless if a right of way permit is required, you
 must provide traffic control if vehicular traffic is impeded, despite time duration.

ODOT:

 There may be some environmental and archeological provisions added to ODOT permits in the near future in the form of a right of way permit disclaimer. John Eden can discuss this further at such a time as this is added to ODOT right of way permits.
