Round Up City Plumbing (818 Airport Road) – new retail sales, warehouse and office
building – ongoing
NW 12 th Street (NW Carden to NW Furnish, NW Horn and NW Ingram) – storm sewer
line – this fall
BMCC (2411 NW Carden Avenue) – new Ag building – Wellens Farwell – ongoing
SE 3 rd St, S Main St and SE Goodwin Ave (by railroad tracks) – water line
repair/replacement from Frazer to Bailey (one block at a time) – awarded to Culbert
Construction – SE 3 rd this fall, Main and Goodwin next spring
