#### **Scott Peters -- ODOT**

- ❖ Working on S. of Maupin job.
- ❖ Moving lane configurations on I-84
- Ready for paving exits 85 & 87.
- Transformer is set to move either Friday or Saturday, weather dependent. May consider a day move to get it across the freeway safely.

#### Ed Ortega - Northern Wasco County PUD

- ❖ 15 mile line relocation. They are currently checking distance of poles to ditch as some may need to be relocated.
- Covenant Christian is doing an expansion on their main building, which sits over a primary power line. PUD is working with them to relocate that line.
- ❖ 2<sup>nd</sup> Street substations will be back in service after an outage last week.

#### **Arthur Smith – Wasco County Public Works**

Continuing general winter maintenance.

#### **Danny Saldivar – The Dalles Irrigation**

- ❖ Met with International Line Builders regarding 10<sup>th</sup> and Cherry Heights. It's a double structure and they will work with Public Works for traffic safety, etc.
- ❖ 9<sup>th</sup>/Walnut replacement project
- Continuing general winter maintenance.

## Nathan Pope -- Chenowith Water

- Currently in winter mode.
- No broken valves.
- Projects will likely begin in March

## **Dale McCabe – City of The Dalles Public Works**

- ❖ Awarded Thompson Street Storm project to Crestline Construction. Anticipated start date is 2-3 weeks out and estimated completion date is 4/29/16. Public Works crews have started working on their portion of the project. Plan to grind and repave Thompson St. in May-June.
- ❖ Still working on 2<sup>nd</sup> St. Storm.
- Trying to get easements for 18" looped water line around the port.
- Working on a 6" water line at Federal and 10<sup>th</sup>.
- \* MCMC's expansion will be discussed at this coming Thursday's Planning Commission Meeting.
- February 10, 2016 there will be a Transportation System Plan (TSP) open to the public. Please get the word out!
