<u>MEETING MINUTES</u> November 17, 2020 8:10 a.m. Zoom/Teleconference

Attendance:

Minutes:

Old Business:

Advertising with Big Screen Ads in The Dalles and Hood River Cinemas during the months of April, May and June 2020 has been extended due to the closure of non-essential businesses. At this time, Nathan with Big Screen Ads does not know when advertising will commence due to the social distancing guidelines set forth by Governor Kate Brown. Damage Report:

Brewster reported that Wasco Electric Cooperative received notification regarding an emergency locate in an orchard. Work was being done, an old de-energized primary underground cable was hit; no call was made to locate prior to digging.

John Amery with Aristo Networks/QLife reported that a tree was fell at The Dalles High School and dropped onto line into the school; no outage occurred.

John also reported that a fiber was cut by the ballfields at 10th and Walnut the week of November 9th. He was seeking information as to who caused the damage. Nikki Fimple with Northern Wasco P.U.D. has information regarding incident and will send information to John Amery and Dale McCabe (if it pertains to The City of The Dalles).
