In speaking with Erica Aitken with Wicks Emmett, Erica indicated that this is the registration that was submitted to the DOJ after receiving the IRS determination letter. The CT-12 is the annual filing report that Wicks Emmett will be filing each year along with the IRS-990-N.

- Contract out to bid for Trevitt Street for utility project running up Trevitt 10th Street up to 17th Street; bidding out this winter, anticipated start Spring 2022
- Street crews working on crack sealing and prepping for winter
- Water crews finishing up project on 6th Street & Garrison

- South County region future development
- Work near Liberty Street old Charter building up to 12th Street
